HEALTH AND GENETIC WARRANTY

Seller's Representations and Warranties:

Seller represents and warrants to Buyer that:

- (a) The Puppy purchased is in sound health and free of communicable diseases at the time of this sale;
- (b) The Puppy has been given all vaccinations and dewormer as stated on the vaccination record provided to the Buyers.
- (c) To the best of Seller's knowledge, the Dog does not have a genetic defect, and if a Vet diagnoses the puppy with a genetic defect, the Sellers shall comply with the below terms;
- (d) Seller does not and will not guarantee the color or size of the dog now or as a full-grown adult.
- (e) This canine is being sold with the following illnesses of health record: ______.

Health and Genetic Warranty Terms

- 1. Buyer has ten (10) days from date of sale to have the Dog examined by a licensed veterinarian, at Buyer's sole cost. To recover under this warranty, the Buyer must present a vet diagnosis from a reputable vet that finds, without a doubt, that the Dog has a genetic defect. A receipt from the vet that is dated within ten (10) business days after the purchase of the Dog must accompany any claims on genetic health. The Seller has a right to confirm or rebut the diagnosis with a veterinarian of their choice. If the diagnosis is affirmed, the Dog can be returned to the Seller, at the Buyer's cost, for a full refund.
- 2. The Seller is not responsible for any expenses incurred in diagnosing a genetic defect, including shipping of the Dog back to the Seller, nor any vet expenses.
- 3. Failure by Buyer to have the Dog examined within the ten (10) day period will nullify this warranty.
- 4. This warranty applies only to the original Buyer.
- 5. This warranty does not include reimbursement for:
 - a. veterinary expenses
 - b. Cherry eye on bulldogs
 - c. reimbursement for air transport or return
 - d. external parasites such as ticks, fleas, or ear mites
- e. internal parasites such as intestinal worms, or their side effects (as almost every puppy has some sort of intestinal worms, despite de-worming the Dog according to a regular de-worming schedule; it only takes a few days for a dog to acquire parasites).

Buyer's Representations and Acknowledgements:

Buyer acknowledges and agrees that Buyer is responsible for all further vaccinations and booster shots from the date of pick-up. Seller strongly recommends (but does not require) that the Dog be spayed or neutered. Buyer is responsible to take good care of the Dog and provide adequate food, water, shelter, and veterinarian care. Hip dysplasia is part hereditary and increasingly environmental. Sellers have bred this Dog based on sound stock, through proper diet, proper exercise and quality living conditions. Buyer plays an important role in helping the Dog grow into a healthy adult by continuing healthy protocols. Seller cannot control the exposure the Dog

encounters after leaving Seller's premises. Dogs may incur stress that leads to illness related to the move, change of diet, too much handling and the stress of adapting to a new situation. This stress can lead to other illnesses such as worms, colds, ear mites, hypoglycemia, coccidiosis, and/or giardiasis. These and other similar conditions are all treatable and do not warrant a replacement, refund, or reimbursement of veterinarian fees.
